RSVP: Not required unless you feel so inclined.

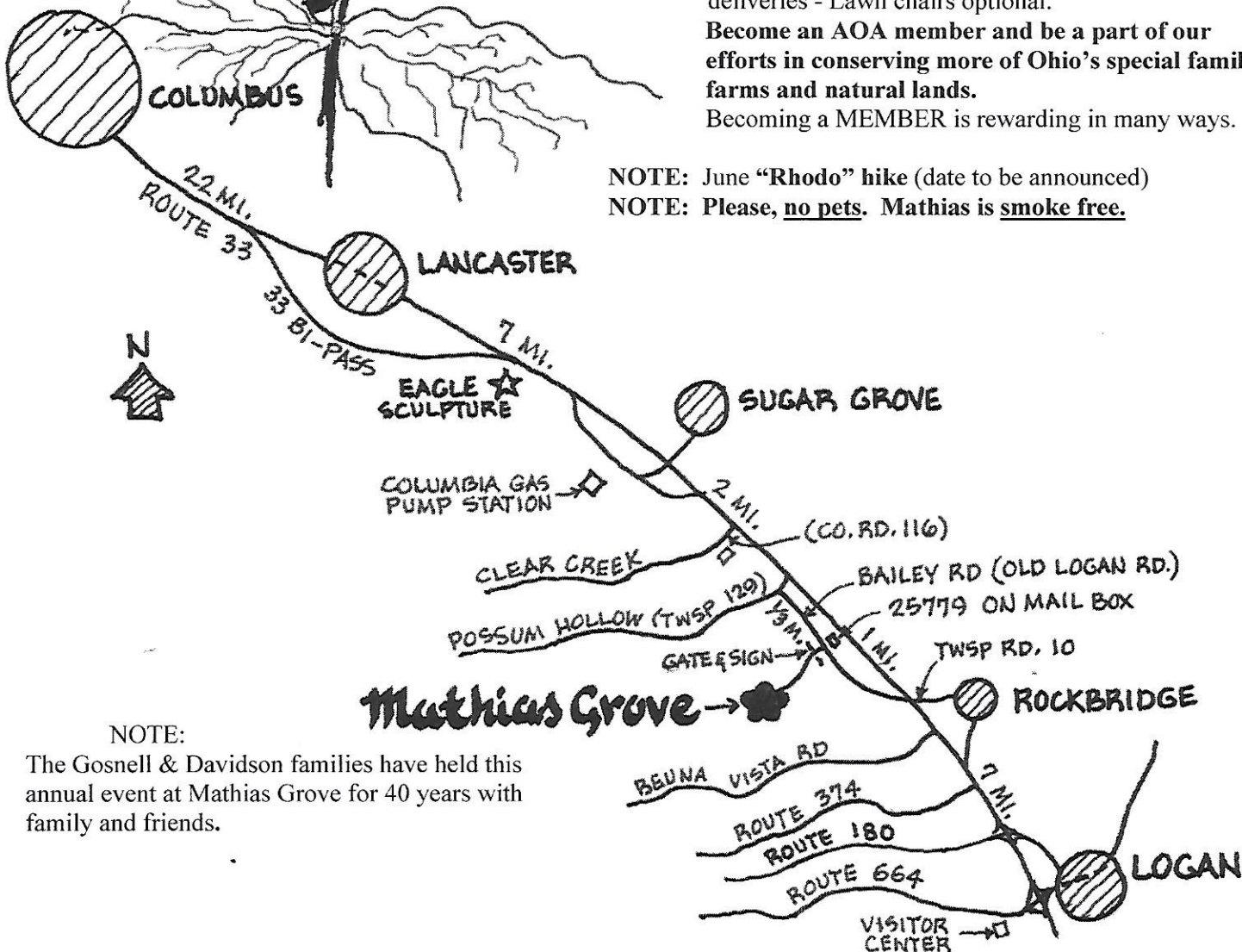
NOTE: Park along Bailey Rd; Drive back lane for deliveries - Lawn chairs optional.
