RSVP: Not required unless you feel so inclined.

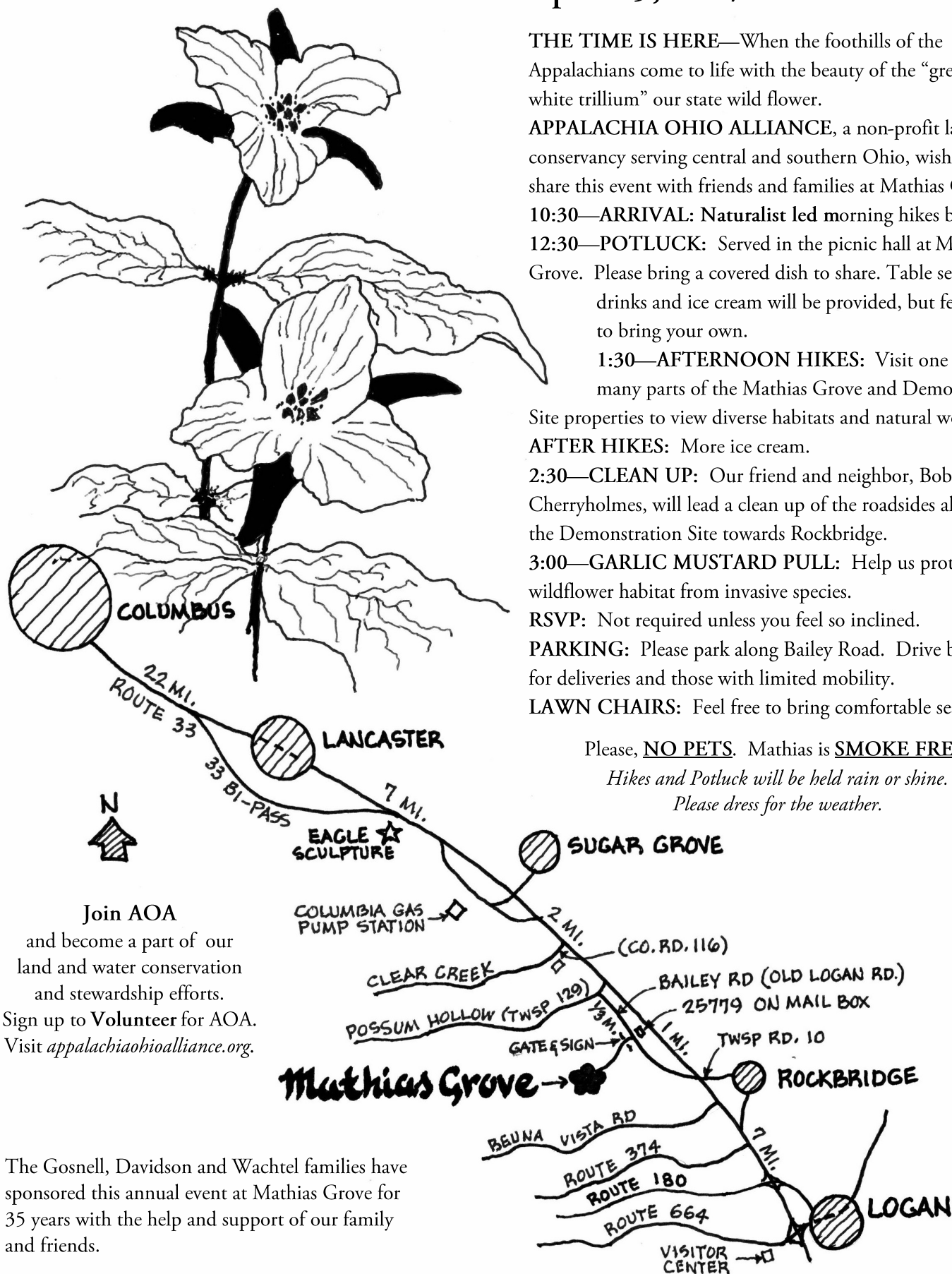
PARKING: Please park along Bailey Road. Drive back only for deliveries and those with limited mobility.
